 - 4. Entry to Village needs new signs stating Village Parking Reg.

IV. OLD BUSINESS

Ordinances Changes/Updates

Pat Tierney passed out 3 books with information and suggestions on planning commission ideas and agenda's. Tom will pass books out to Plan Commission members for review and suggestions. He also shared with the committee the idea of issuing a "PERMIT SIGN" to be placed in the home owner's window that will indicate the work that the permit is for and dates. Permit sign could be issued by clerk after approval of improvements by the planning commission.

House on Lathrop and Taylor Avenue added a deck without a building permit. – Clerk to send letter to owners requesting they appear before the planning commission at the next meeting with their plans for the deck and to acquire a permit.

Owners of a house on Green Meadows put up a shed which had not been permitted by the Planning Commission due to setbacks – Clerk to send letter to owners requesting they appear before the planning commission at the next meeting.

House on Standish Lane had new driveway put in and a large amount of drywall delivered – no permits were applied for. President Mills to investigate further.

Clark Homestead had new electrical put on side of home – President Mills stopped by and introduced himself and asked about a permit – owners said they would follow up with the planning commission about it but nothing has resulted.

Taylor Avenue property has been listed with a Realtor. All offers received shall be brought to the Board of Trustees and Planning Commission for a decision.

Some of the improvements that will be made to the Taylor Avenue property with the additional funds from the refinance to include:

Make each building handicap accessible. Separate electric for each building.

Current tenants: Building 2 – Building Blocks, Building 4 – RADD, Spirituality Group and Village Hall, Buildings 1 and 5 are vacant. The hall rental in Building 3 has increased since the painting and cleaning took place and the gym rental has also increased.
